Those who buy Tishrei memberships, individual ticket holders, and visitors with reciprocity letters will be <u>listed</u> as well. Visiting military personnel and college students are welcome at no cost with appropriate I.D.

PLEASE NOTE - Pursuant to Temple Israel policy, members must be current in *ALL* financial obligations to the Temple in order to attend High Holy Day Services. If you have any questions about your status, please call the Temple President, Mike Slotkin, at the Temple office.

SPECIAL NEEDS – If you or a member of your family have special needs that require our attention during the High Holy Days, including accommodations for worshippers with disabilities, please call the Temple office. The Quiet Room is adjacent to the sanctuary, which allows participation in the service through a speaker system and picture window. Feel free to use the Quiet Room if you require a less stimulating environment for participation in the services or for your children.

PARKING – Because parking at Temple Israel is limited, Freedom Christian Center (our neighbor next door) has agreed to share their parking lot for our holidays.

TRANSPORTATION – If you are in need of a ride to Temple for services, please contact the Temple and we will try to help.

FLORAL FUND – As is our custom, the Bimah is dressed with beautiful fresh flowers for the holidays. If you would like to contribute to this fund, your donation would be appreciated by all who attend our services.
